What will your donation provide?

Your donation will be used for the care of your sponsored dog's daily needs such as food, treats, maintenance of his/her kennel and medical expenses (including vaccinations and medications).

As an acknowledgement, we will place your name or a message (e.g. "Sponsored by" Or "In Memory of") on the Sponsor A Dog webpage.

You will receive monthly photographs and updates of your sponsored dog via WhatsApp. Of course, you could arrange to have interaction time with your sponsored fur kid. However, this requires prior appointment and the type of interaction will depend on his/her personality.

How much does it cost?

It would cost an estimate of \$300 per month for each dog that is up for sponsorship.
