SPCA FUN RUN 2010

The Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA) is holding its Fun Run 2010 on Sunday 27 June. This 4.8 km run/walk will take place at MacRitchie Reservoir Park.

The Fun Run is one of the biggest events in SPCA's fundraising calendar, having raised over \$18,579 in 2006. This year, we are hoping to attract at least 500 participants. The income received, will be used to help sustain the various services that SPCA provides for abused and abandoned pets and strays. The SPCA relies mainly on the generosity of the public for funding and does not receive any government grants.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

In 2009:

The SPCA took in 7,678 unwanted pets and stray animals. It is the only animal welfare organisation that has a shelter and does not turn away any animal that is brought in.

The SPCA's 24-hour Emergency Rescue Service handled 1,929 animals.

The SPCA investigated 864 cruelty complaints.

Our Education Department gave 116 talks in schools and arranged 133 group visits to the SPCA for schools and other organizations. We reached out to 72,000 students and adults about the importance of animal welfare issues.

1,159 animals found homes through the SPCA adoption programme.

179 stray animals were sterilised at the SPCA clinic.

SPCA distributed 1,566 sterilisation vouchers that enabled members of the public to sterilise stray animals at participating private veterinary clinics with SPCA bearing the costs.

472 lost dogs were reunited with their owners.
